

**For 38 million women in America,
abortion is not a political issue:**

A New Pro-Life Choice Movement

After completing residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology, Dr. Carolyn Purcell remained in Lexington, Kentucky for private practice from 1977 to 1998. During that time she counseled hundreds of women as they made and lived with decisions about unplanned pregnancies. Their pain broke her heart. In retirement she wrote a work of fiction, "Saving Jane Doe," to say to them that there is healing and forgiveness.

Besides writing, Dr. Purcell's retirement has been busy. She served as chairman of the advisory board of The Salvation Army, worked in disaster relief at Ground Zero, ran for state representative in 2004, was host mother for a teenage girl from Germany, and was caregiver in her home for her elderly mother for a year and a half.

Dr. Purcell calls her position on abortion Pro-Life Choice. She believes women should have a right to choose and she believes abortion is almost always the wrong choice. After 43 years of internal conflict over this issue, she has peace having decided that she would rather be compassionate than right.

With previous media experience in regional radio, TV news and talk shows, Dr. Purcell is ready to share her positions and thoughts on this controversial practice with the public.

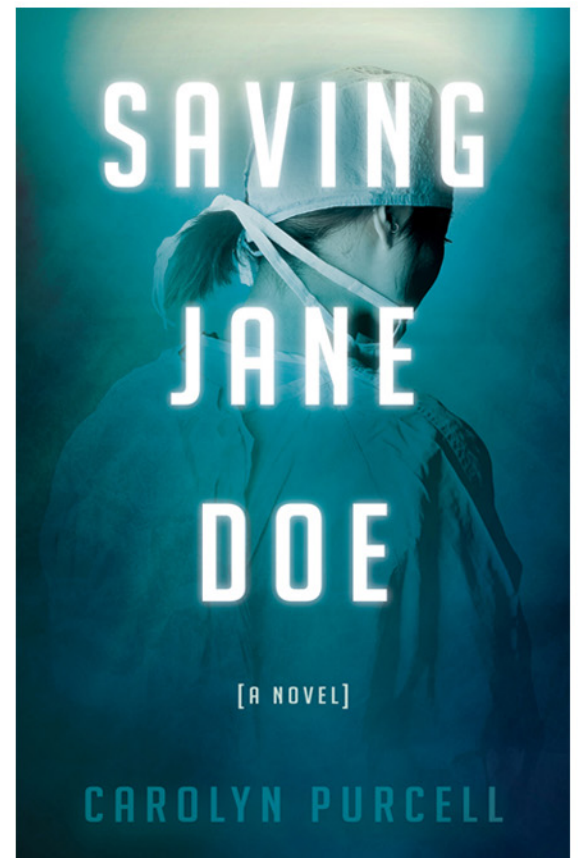
